The **EU4Digital initiative** aims to extend the European Union efforts to develop harmonised and interoperable eHealth services, in Eastern partner countries, and within the EU.

The **EU4Digital eHealth team** activities include:

- ✓ Develop common harmonisation and interoperability guidelines and standards for the EaP region.

- ✓ Cross-border eHealth platform.

- ✓ Involve the EaP region in relevant EU programmes, projects and initiatives.

The World Health Organisation defines **eHealth** as “**the use of information and communication technologies (ICT) for health**”. eHealth introduces new ways of providing health-care services by easing collaboration between different institutions and allowing the sharing of crucial information, enabling better, more efficient health care for patients.

Facilitate participation in the **European Innovation Partnership on Active and Healthy Ageing (EIP on AHA)**, - a platform that connects a **network** of Reference Sites and contains a repository of good practices among other collaboration opportunities.

The concept of eHealth supports the idea of introducing **effective communications** between different healthcare environments via electronic means.



Patient Summary and **ePrescription** are the two well-known eHealth services supported by the **EU4Digital** initiative.



Cross-border eHealth infrastructure ensures the continuity of care for Eastern partnership citizens while they are travelling abroad in the Eastern partner countries.



The **cross-border Patient Summary** service will help healthcare providers to better understand the patient's medical history, especially when the health professional and patient do not share the same language.



Sharing information on COVID-19

During the coronavirus crisis, the EU4Digital **eHealth Network** brought partners together to address responses to the COVID-19 outbreak. An **online workshop** was an opportunity for the EU4Digital eHealth team to share insights into global eHealth

responses to the pandemic, while a **virtual meeting** between EC and Eastern partners was an opportunity for information sharing on best practices specifically COVID-19 data collection, for tracking infection rates.
