## e-CODEX at a glance

- **Project:** 10 years since December 2010
- **Result:** European digital technical solutions for fast, reliable and secure online cross-border communication between competent legal authorities in both criminal and civil law.
- **Partners:** 27 Partners from 25 countries (incl. NO, TR) & CCBE, CNUE
- **Live since:** July 2013 (civil law procedures) & November 2015 (criminal law procedures)

# Flagship project of European e-Justice

- Allows digital cross-border exchange between courts, public prosecutors and other competent authorities
- Generic, reusable solution for cross-border data exchange in the area of Justice
- Merely digitalizes the analogue communication and exchange process that is already there.
- Working method based on active involvement of user communities for each specific use case, while respecting national process design and judicial peculiarities in MS.

## Me-CODEX II (maintenance of e-CODEX)

- MoJNL is responsible for community & external relations management within the Me-CODEX II project
- Outside the project:
  - Handover to eu-LISA
  - e-CODEX regulation
- Inside the project:
  - Preparation of handover
  - Dissemination: more participants, more relevant use cases
  - Technical and social sustainability

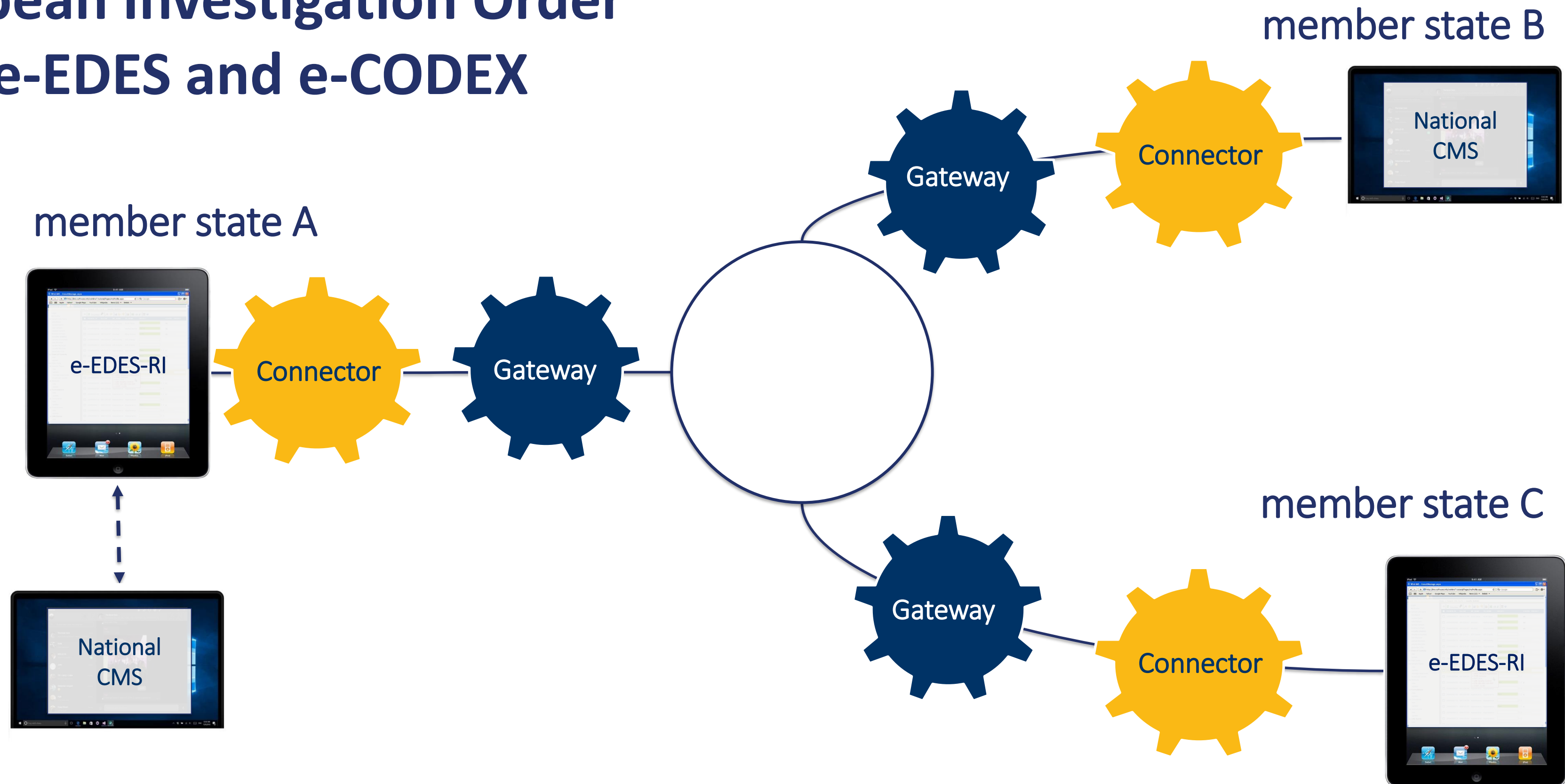
# Civil law procedures supported by e-CODEX

- European Payment Order
- Small Claims Procedure
- Insolvency Register Interconnection
- Business Register Interconnection
- In view: Service of Documents (Council Regulation (EC) No 1393/2007), see Art. 3a of the proposal of an amending Regulation
- In view: Cooperation between the courts in the taking of evidence in civil or commercial matters (Council Regulation (EC) No 1206/2001), see Art. 6 of the proposal of an amending Regulation

## Criminal law procedures supported by e-CODEX

- European Investigation Order (e-EDES implementation)
- Mutual Recognition of Financial Penalties
- Potentially:
  - Exchange of digital evidence
    - EVIDENCE2e-CODEX Project (2018-2020)
    - Possible follow up as part of EXEC II
  - E-Evidence Regulation (third parties)
  - European Arrest Warrant
  - Forms regarding prisoner exchange

## Final remarks

- e-CODEX is a mature solution
- The software is free of charge
- Existing national solutions are respected
- Only one interface is needed to communicate with all MS
