EU4Digital Facility in eHealth area

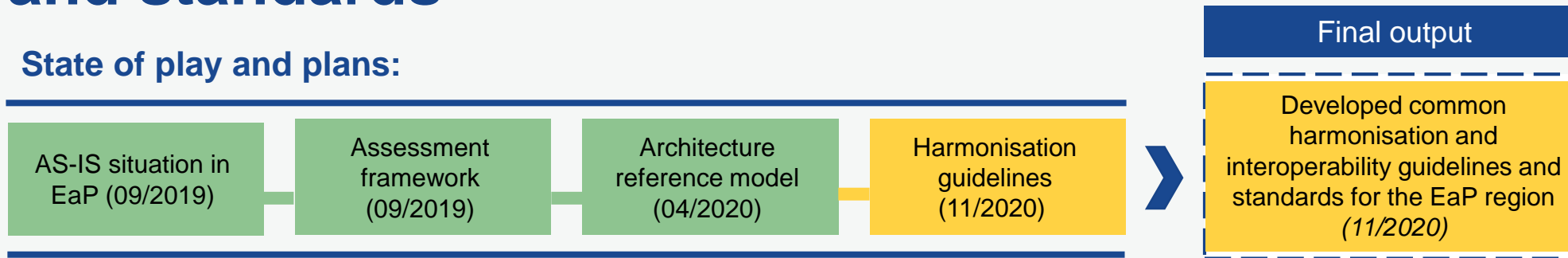


- Develop eHealth harmonisation guidelines and standards for the EaP region

State of play and plans:

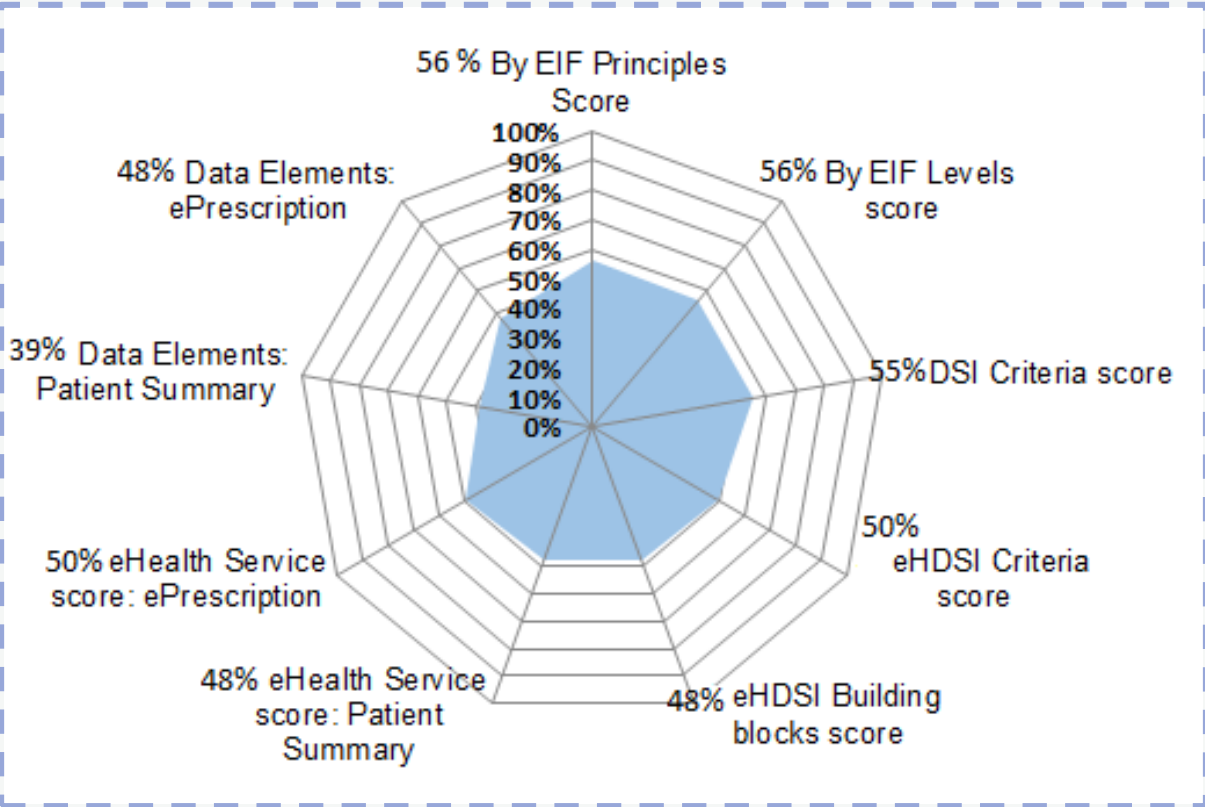


- Defined initial eHealth harmonisation and interoperability guidelines for EaP countries based on assessment results
- Active involvement and consultations with EU Delegations, HDM coordinators as well as eHealth Network participants, build a comprehensive view on development status and needs, and thus provides the common ground for harmonized policy making and activation of next initiatives
- Created individual as well as aggregated country eHealth assessments on interoperability and harmonisation level including the COVID-19 practices
- Made each countries' eHealth architectural landscape matching with the reference architecture
- Arranged country sharing session on COVID-19 response practice

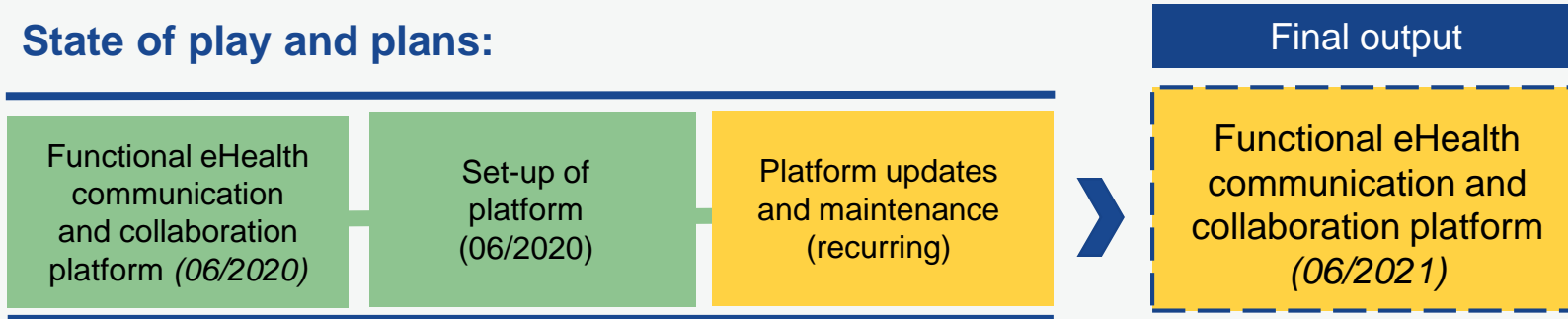

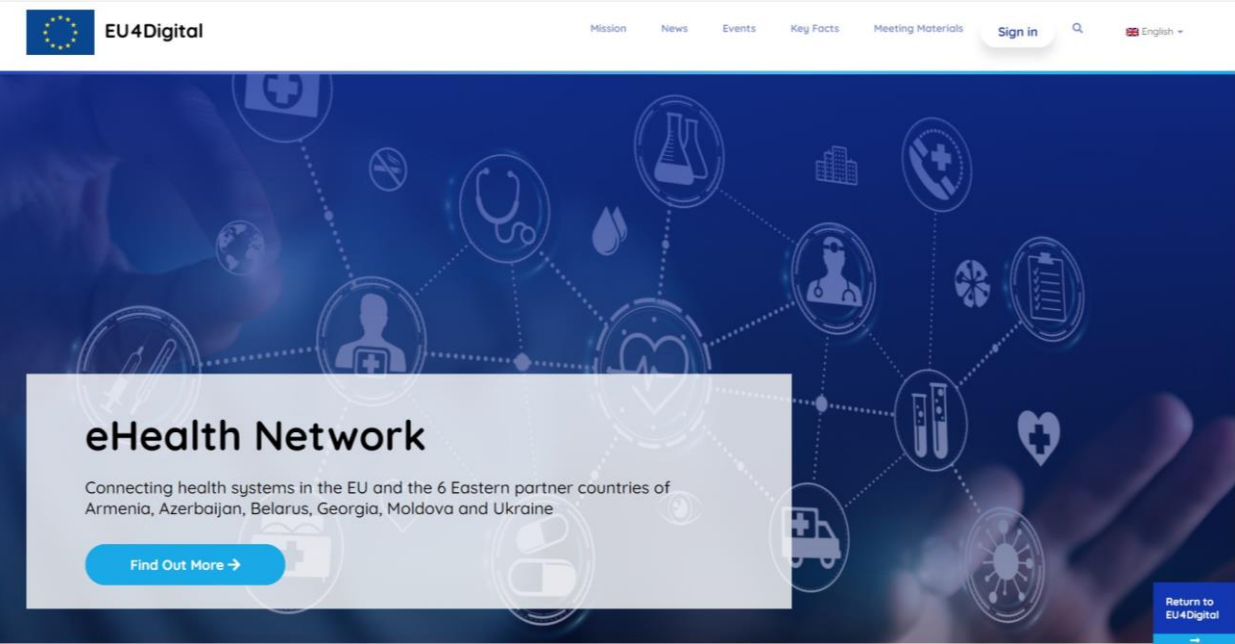
State of play and plans:



- **eHealth communication and collaboration platform consists of 2 parts: 1) communication portal and 2) collaboration space**
- **eHealth communication portal with populated initial contents has been launched:**
 - A dedicated communication portal as part of EU4Digital website. The portal provides eHealth related and publicly accessible news, events and subject matter material in order to establish common awareness on eHealth related activities.
- **eHealth collaboration space was launched, dedicated to the internal collaboration of eHealth stakeholders from Eastern partner countries providing:**
 - one space for collaboration and action for the group of assigned representatives of partner countries
 - the repository combines relevant content about EU and eastern partner countries practices in eHealth
 - Further focus on content enrichment of collaboration space as well as activities promoting communication, country practice sharing and collaboration among eHealth experts

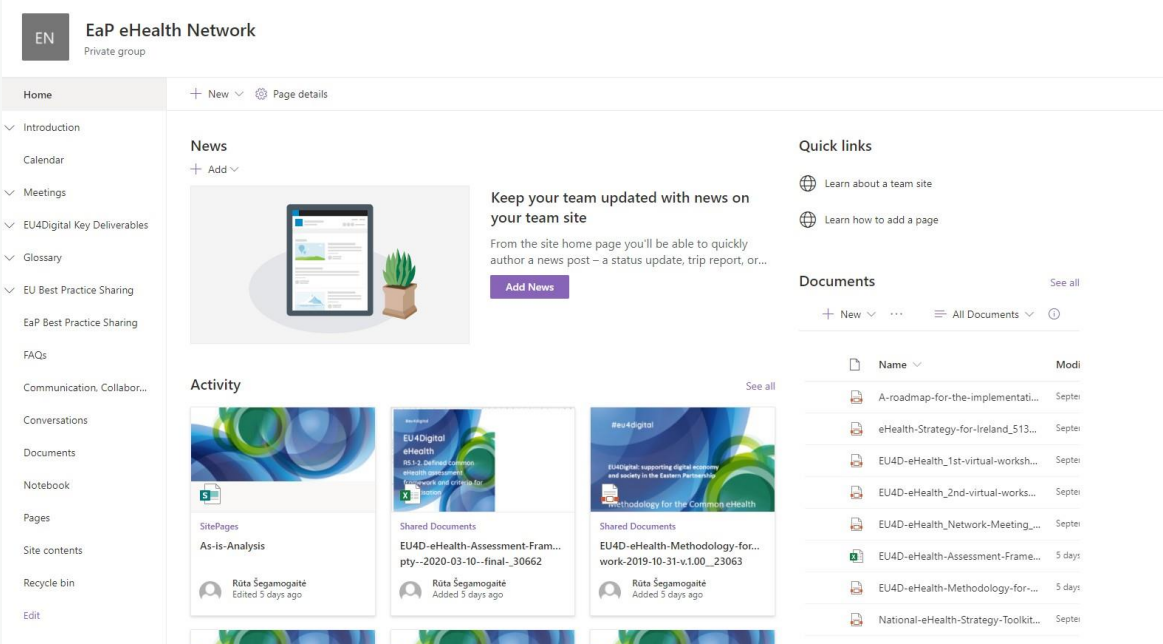

Communication portal



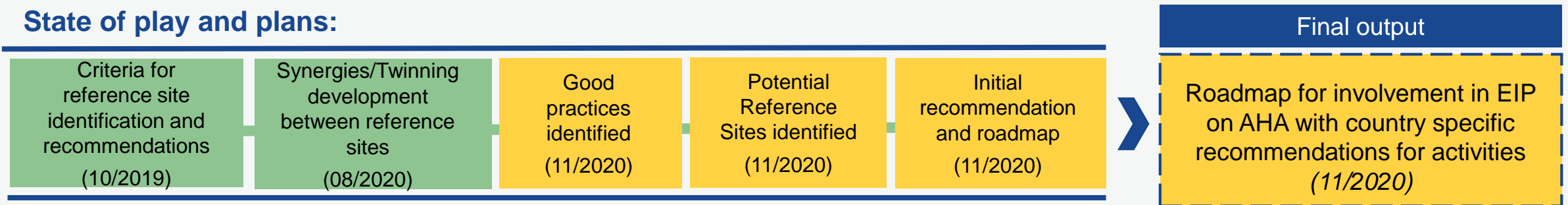

3. EaP involvement in EU initiatives

State of play and plans:



- Provided recommendations on participation in Action Groups per country by identified innovation interests and priorities – areas of highest potential in pursuit of eHealth innovation are proactive prevention and digital (remote) health, and (integrated) care
- Provided twinning recommendations per country
- Established Candidate Reference Site for building an ecosystem of stakeholders in 1 country (GE)

International visibility achieved in eHealth innovation through EIP on AHA instruments:

- Building Reference Sites and Action Groups – to design and execute different programs that build ecosystems of stakeholders for solving particular health and ageing issues (e.g. remote health services, prescription management, etc.)
- Building of collaborations and synergies through Twinning – exchange of practices between Reference Sites

eHealth area beyond 2021

Considerations for the future



- Articulation of eHealth strategies (2021)
- Piloting eHealth data space concept/ Covid19-oriented case
- Piloting ePrescription among EaP countries (2025)
- Establishing reference sites and substantiating twinning schemes
- Building data protection and cyber resilience capabilities for eHealth
