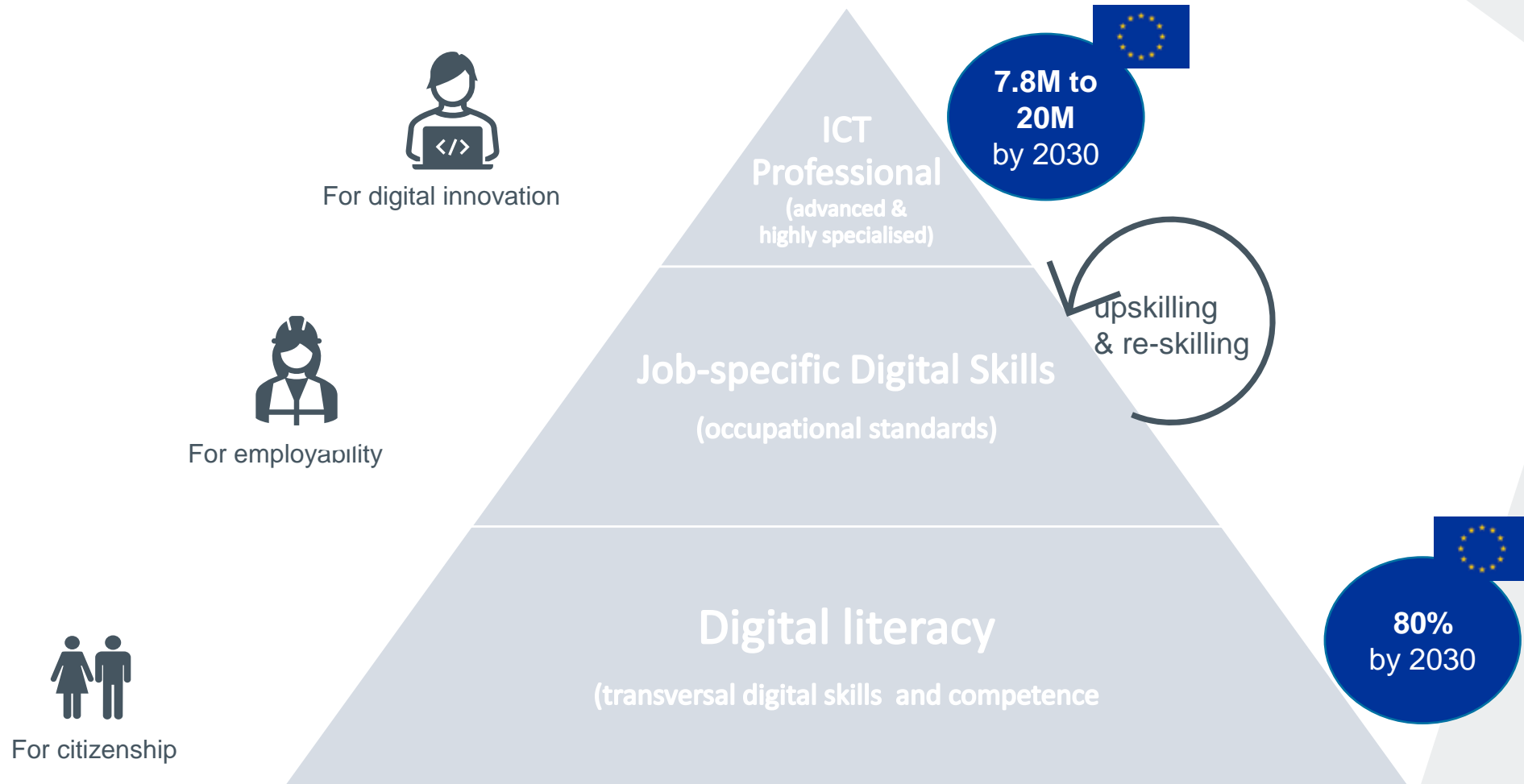

Digital skills: key EU targets

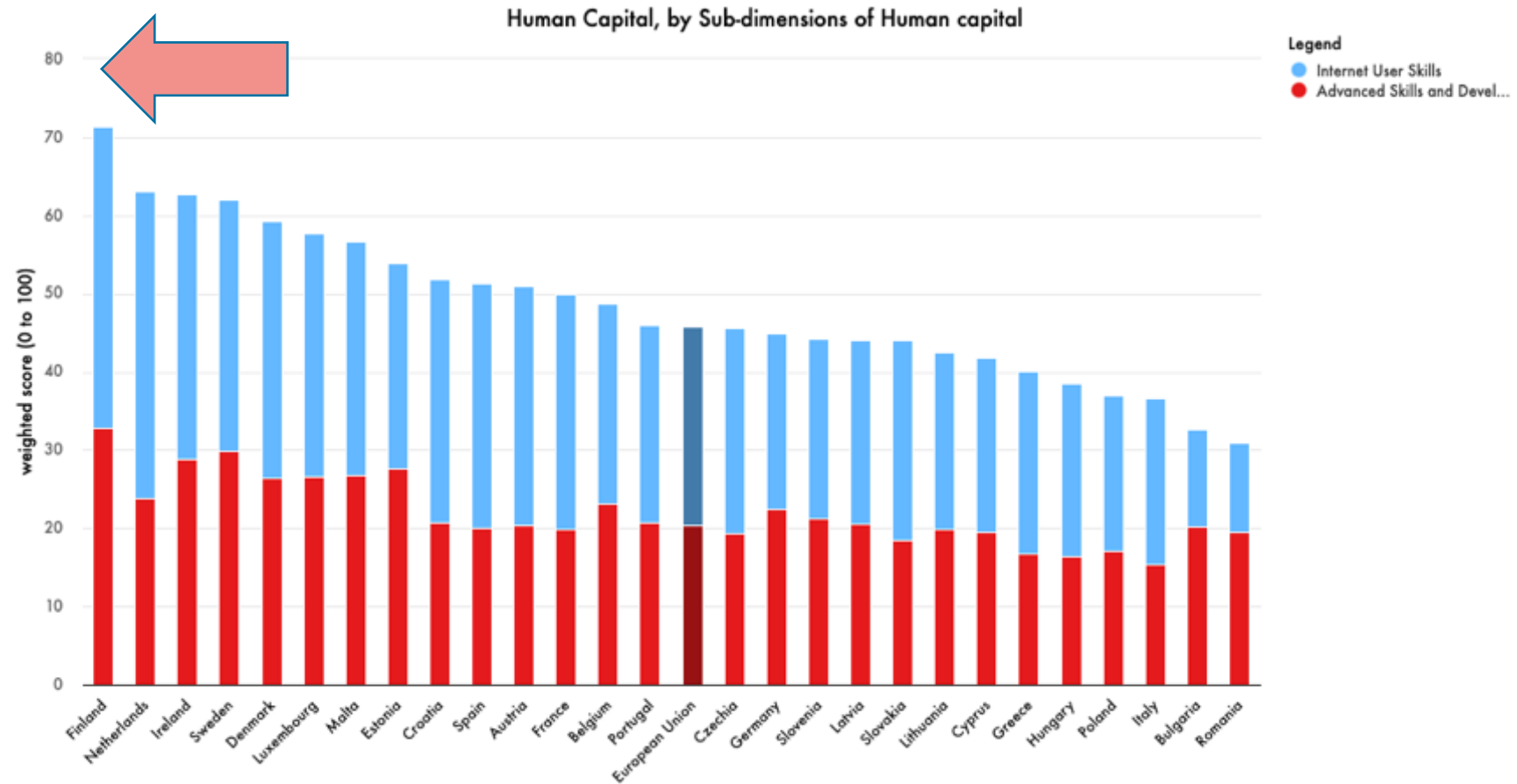


Digital competences and skills are essential to give every individual an equal chance to thrive in life, find employment and to be an engaged citizen.

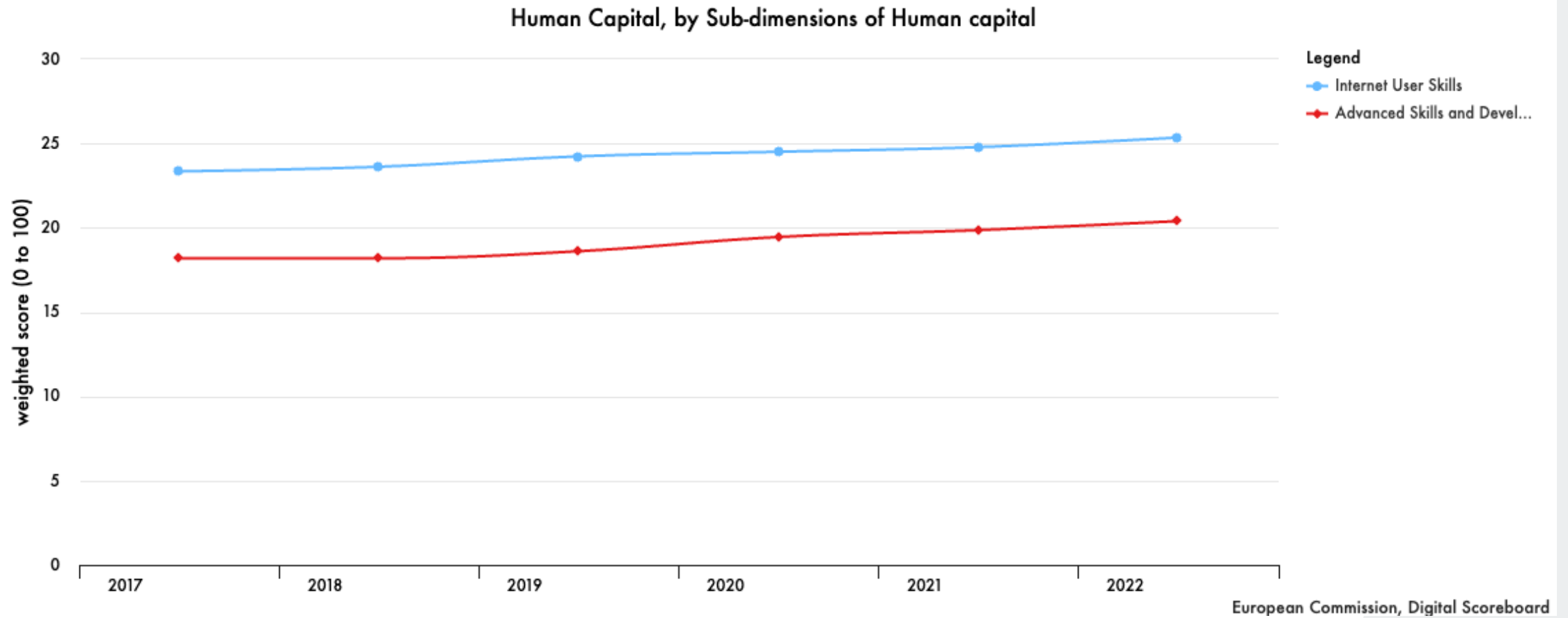


Digital Skills: where are we in the EU?

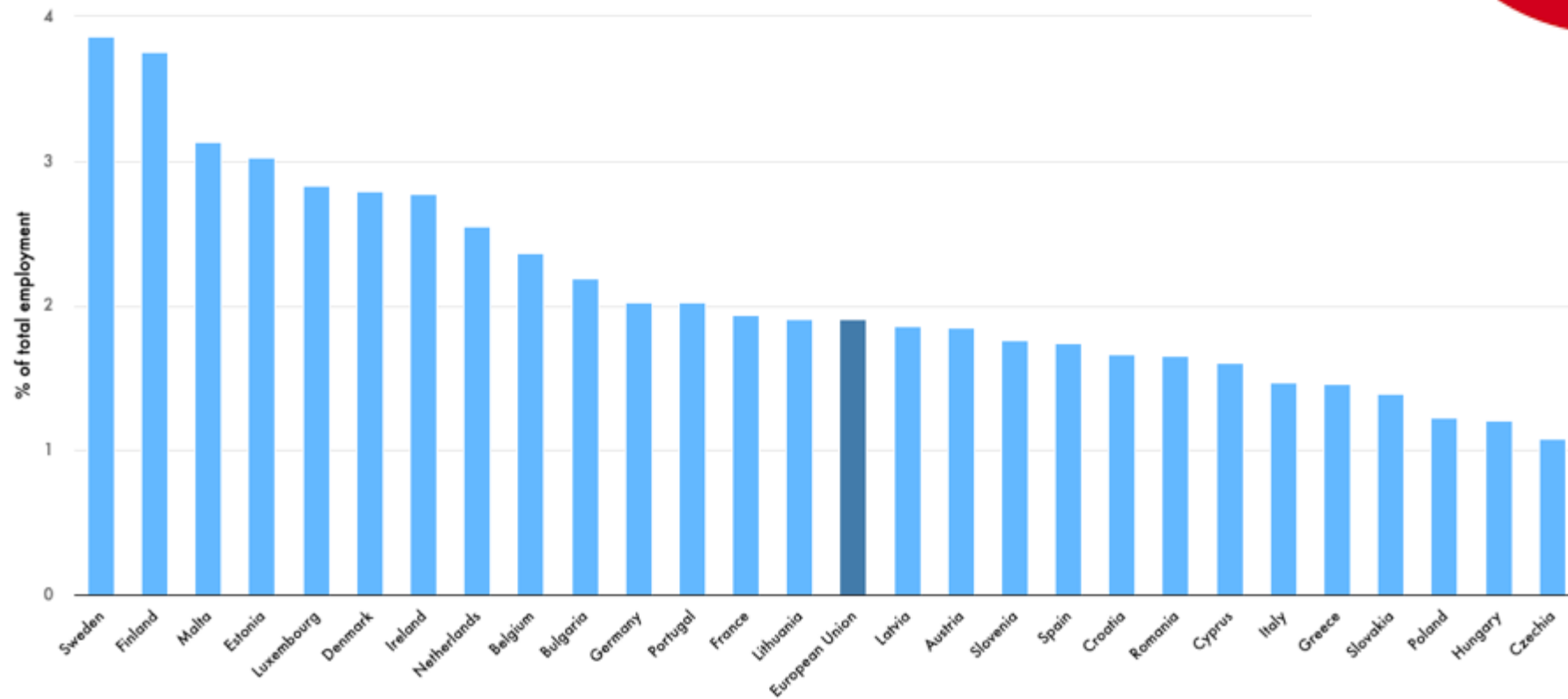

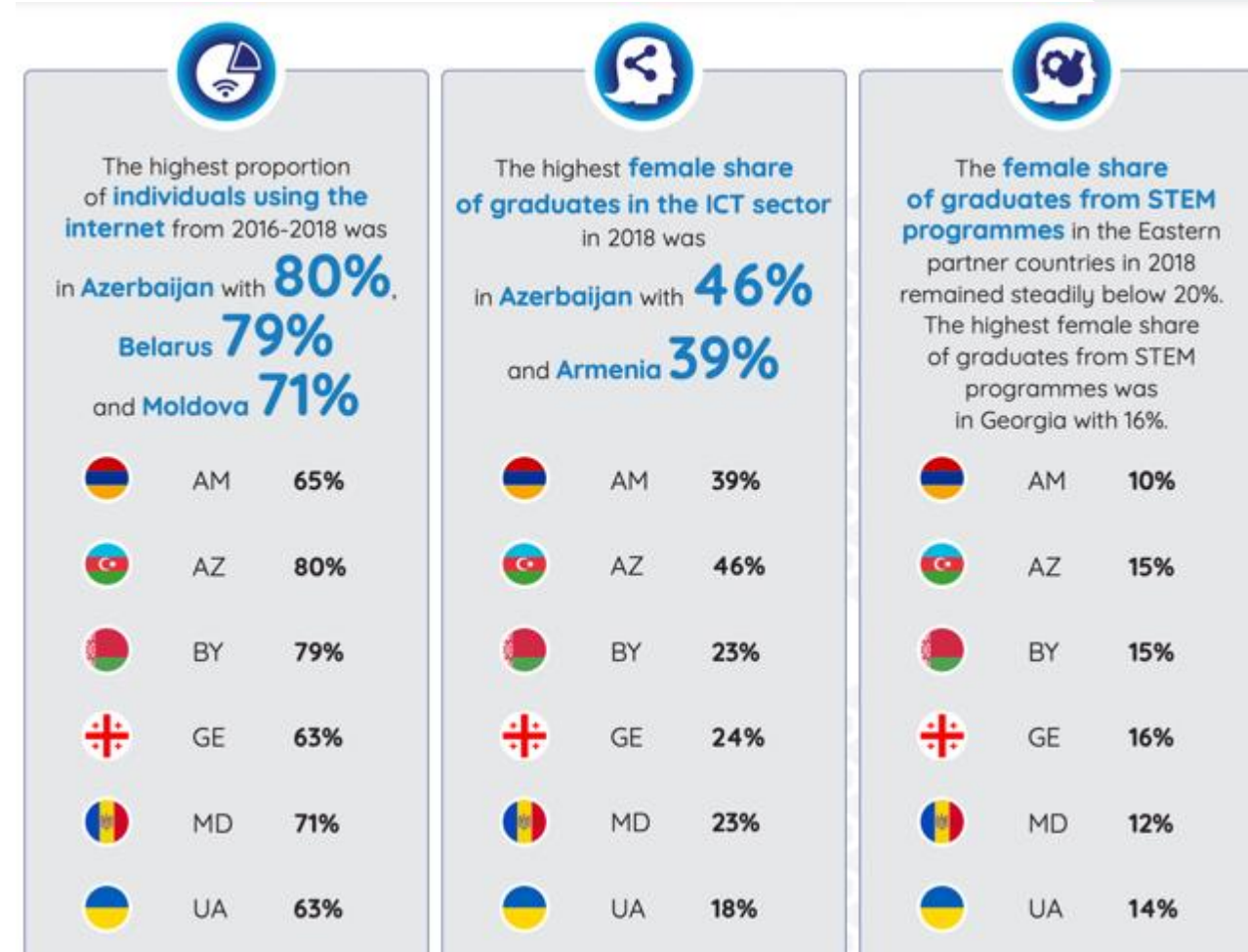
Digital Skills in the EaP

A clear priority in all EaP countries (ETF policy monitoring, 2022)

Ambitious target: 1M EaP digitally-skilled citizens

Uneven capacity to measure digital skills (EU4Digital, 2019 and 2020)

Work going on to use **DESI** for data collection and measurement in **all EaP countries**



ETF: Measuring & supporting digital skills

New area of monitoring of the Torino Process (2022): equitable digitalisation

Will provide a proxy for the level of LLL system digitalisation, including digital skills

Continuous analysis of Digital Education policies & support to countries

Currently: Armenia, Moldova, Ukraine

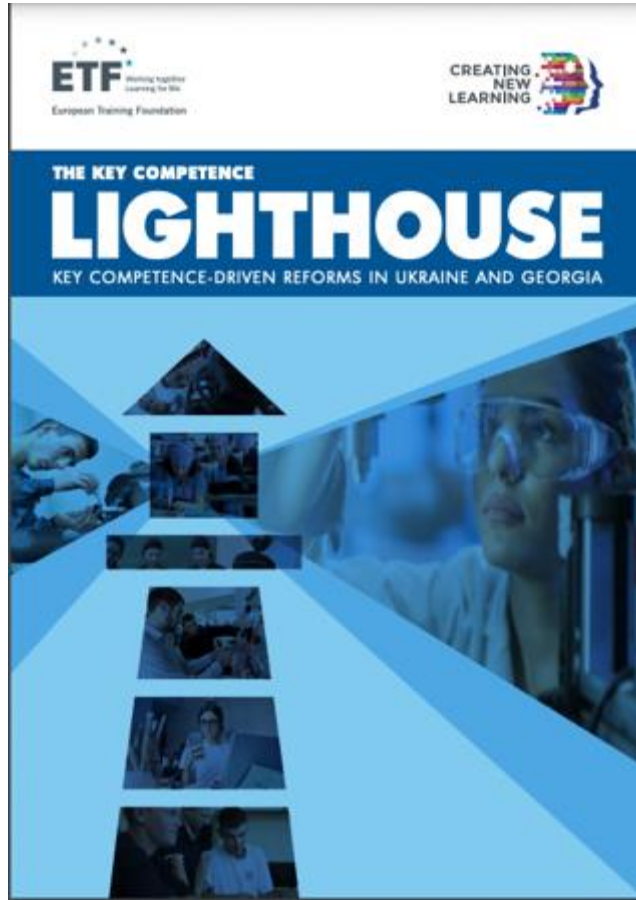
SELFIE bottom-up approach, gathering aggregated anonymised data, based on representative sample of schools, **empowering schools as engines of digital change.**
