





Kharkiv University of Humanities "People's Ukrainian Academy"



1972 educational entities (schools, universities and so on) were hit by bombings and shelling.

194 of them were completely destroyed.

Kharkiv is the second city in Ukraine by the density of science and education. Practically all Research and Education entities in Kharkiv are damaged.
