- Secure 5G networks by alignment with the EU coordinated approach
- Applied in full Regional Spectrum Agreement among the EaP countries







eTrust and Cross-border Digital Services area (1/2)

- At least four EaP countries with mutually recognised digital signatures between each other and with the EU.
- Increased number of documents transferred cross-border being digitally signed.
- Aligned data protection standards with the EU and international ones, in order to facilitate commercial exchanges and law enforcement.
- 80% of **public services** available online through interoperable platforms.

- Increased cross-border e-commerce with the EU by 50%



- Preparatory work for full-scale implementation
- Implementation of SEED+ nodes to exchange data set regarding cargo and empty trucks. Additional scope – connect Phytosanitary authorities
- Agreed with participating Customs administrations on the scenarios and data sets to be piloted
- Analysis of EU practices in exchanging electronic freight transport information
- State of play assessment for Azerbaijan, Ukraine, Moldova
- Designed roadmap to pilot and establish Digital Transport Corridor in line with eFTI regulation




