# **EU4Digital ICT Innovation networking event**

## **CONCEPT OUTLINE**

When and where: 2 March 2021, 8:30 - 11:30 (CET), online.

**Concept:** The EU4Digital Initiative will hold ICT Innovation networking event remotely in form of virtual session. The concept of the event is provided in this document.

Language: The event will be held in English.

**Topic:** Strengthening the capacity of national patent offices, IPR consultants and other innovation ecosystem actors to provide IPR-related services for start-ups and SMEs in EaP region.

#### Goals:

- 1. Provide better knowledge on tools and possibilities offered by European IP Office (<u>EUIPO</u>) including those that can be made available to the EaP region, including:
  - a. Innovative tools and services for EUIPO customers (members) using next-generation technologies, including blockchain and artificial intelligence (e.g. IP Innovation databases);
  - b. Professional traineeship programme for IP professionals (<u>Pan-European Seal</u>) and trainings delivered via <u>EUIPO Academy for SMEs</u>;
  - c. Projects organised to support SMEs (e.g. Ideas Powered for Business SME Fund);
- Promote among the EaP participants tools and services of <u>European IP Helpdesk</u> supporting SMEs on IPR protection and management issues (<u>Helpline</u>, <u>Signposting Directory</u>, <u>Online Library</u>, <u>Training</u> & Events).
- 3. Promote the European IP Helpdesk <u>Ambassadors</u> (available in Belarus and the Republic of Moldova).
- 4. Discuss the opportunities of capacity building of national patent offices (NPO), technology transfer centres and other innovation ecosystem actors in EaP countries to provide services for start-ups and SMEs on IPR-related issues.

## Target audience in EaP countries:

- Ministerial level representatives and agencies coordinating the development of innovation ecosystem;
- National patent offices;
- Business incubators, accelerators, other innovation support and consultancy organisations;
- Technology transfer offices, including those at universities and R&D organisations.

Number of participants: around 40 - 60.

### **Key EU participants:**

- The European Commission (DG GROW);
- <u>European IP Office</u> (EUIPO);
- European IP Helpdesk.

### Potential cooperation areas:

- Registration of additional EaP organisations to the <u>European IP Helpdesk's Signposting Directory</u> database that is providing access to key institutions and services active in the fields of intellectual property, research and/or business support<sup>1</sup>;
- Collaboration on capacity building of NPOs, IPR consultancy organisations, technology transfer centres and other innovation ecosystem actors in EaP countries to provide services for start-ups and SMEs on IPR-related issues.
- Elaboration of joint projects/programmes with <u>European IP Office</u> enabling the EaP stakeholders to
  access the selected EUIPO tools and possibilities (e.g. via <u>international cooperation framework</u>, the
  Neighbourhood, Development and International Cooperation Instrument (<u>NDICI</u>), similar
  to <u>EUGIPP</u> project for Georgia).
