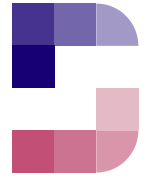

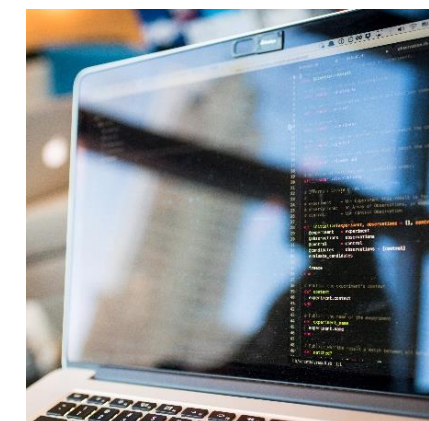


## Latvia

- ▶ **Other NGO and bodies :** Federation of Employers ( France ), Chamber of Commerce and Industry ( Slovenia ) , Irish Computer Society ( Ireland ) and other
- ▶ **Other solutions –** eSkills Foundation Malta; Bulgaria



# Main priorities

- ▶ **National digital skills strategies – Policy level**
- ▶ **National Digital skills initiatives – projects and implementation level :**
  - ▶ Coordination
  - ▶ Funding
  - ▶ Promotion
- ▶ **Monitoring digital skills indicators and National strategies effectiveness**

Depending of coordinator type Top –Down or Bottom-Up approaches in place
