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1. Participant information

1.1. Armenia eID and digital trust services profile

The modernization of identity documents issuance system in 2011 introduced the ID cards with eID and digital signatures certificates. Starting 2012 Armenian citizens who have an ID card can pass electronic identification in different platforms free of charge. Around 1 million citizens currently have an ID card. Currently there are two main solutions available: eID (signature and identification using card reader) and mID (Mobile ID). The usage of eID is dominant. The state revenue committee accepts reports from the companies exceptionally in online format, which means that at least the directors and accountants of business entities sign digitally regularly.

1.1.1. Implementation approach

Armenia is to develop a web-based service for signing XAdES-LTA according to the Common format using the DSS library. A dedicated section at http://www.ekeng.am will give possibility for Armenian ID-card holders to sign, upload, and check the validity of signatures created in Common format by Armenian, Georgian, Ukrainian, and Estonian entities.

Armenian ID-card with qualified certificates will be used for signature creation.
