Dreamups Innovation and Entrepreneurship Accelerator is an organization which develops an entire ecosystem of programs: education and simulation programs for students in schools and universities; Startup accelerators, idea stage and traction; a product leadership and product management school for IT outsourcing companies in

Eastern Europe, community building events and an angel investors network. In eight years, Dreamups worked with almost 7,000 direct beneficiaries, generated over 50 startups from scratch, and raised 750,000 euros for eight startups.
